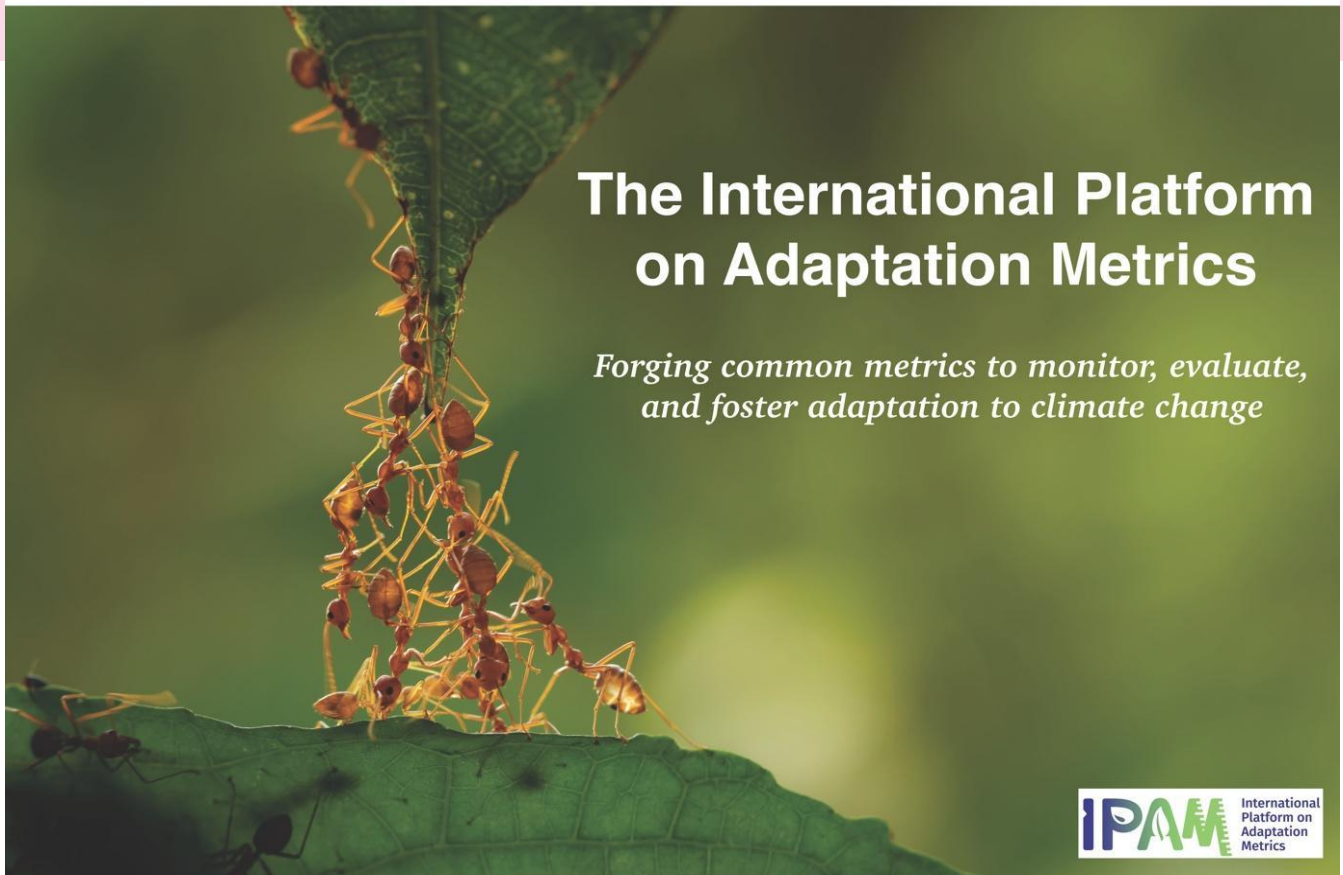

1) IPAM welcomes new member organisations:

The [International Platform on Adaptation Metrics](#) is a member-led initiative, governed by member organizations.

After almost two years of activity, including the elaboration of a common vision (the “Adaptation Metrics Mapping & Evaluation ([AMME](#)) Framework”) [presented at CoP26](#) and substantial exchange between its [64 individual members](#) within the four IPAM thematic committees, there is a demand for expansion as more consensus arises on the imperative to focus on adaptation metrics.

Benefits of Organisations Membership include:

- Member Organisations may have a vote and **become a member of the Steering Committee** .
- Member Organisations are **acknowledged on IPAM materials** (e.g. website, letterhead) and may note affiliation with IPAM on publications or events.
- Member Organisations, with the consent of the Steering Committee, may **represent IPAM at specific events**.
- Member organisations may **receive funds granted to IPAM**, subject to the approval of the Steering Committee.

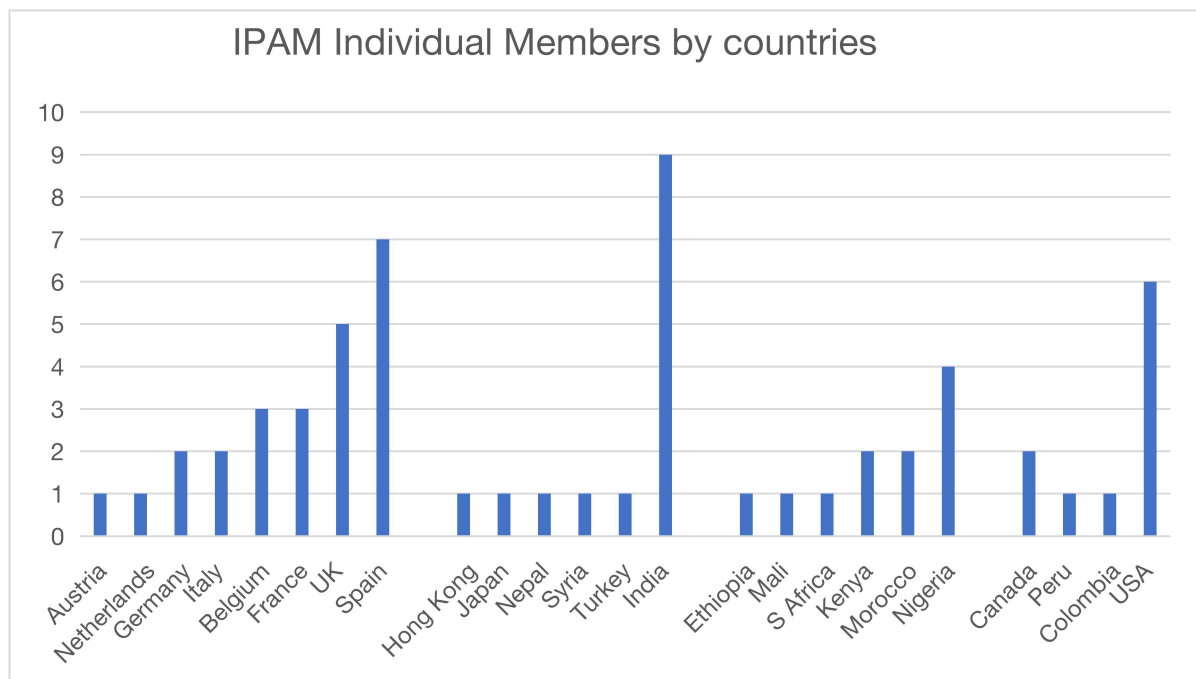

The first applications will be examined at our **next Steering Committee meeting on April 8th** and you will then receive our official answer.

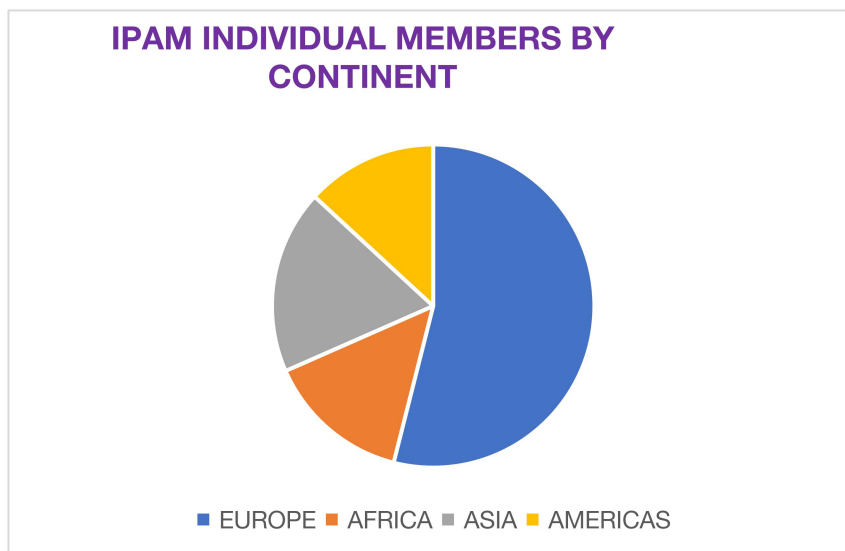
2) Our committees are expanding :

To be considered as a **member candidate**, organisations must have at least one representative affiliated as an individual member to at least one IPAM thematic committee

IPAM already comprises **64 individual members** contributing to the works of its four thematic committees.



The actual individual members are from 24 distinct countries (38% from Europe, 22% from Asia, 17% from Africa and 16% from the Americas)



3) Projects ideas are emerging :

IPAM is structured around a common vision the “Adaptation Metrics Mapping & Evaluation (AMME) Framework”, which is free to download on our website.

With our 64 individual members from four continents contributing to the works of the four IPAM thematic committees, many project ideas are emerging and a few have been briefly described by their proponents in our Post CoP26 webinar which you can follow on our website.
